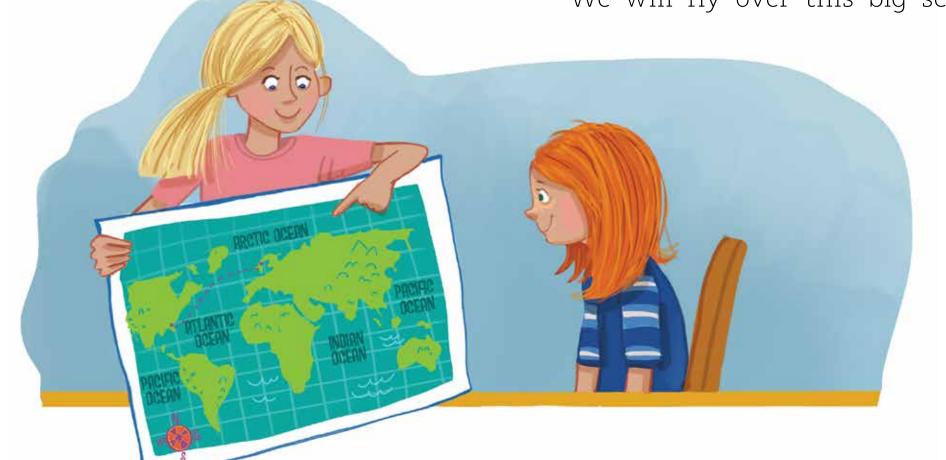


Sara and Mom planned to go to Sweden!
