Ben plays with the clay.



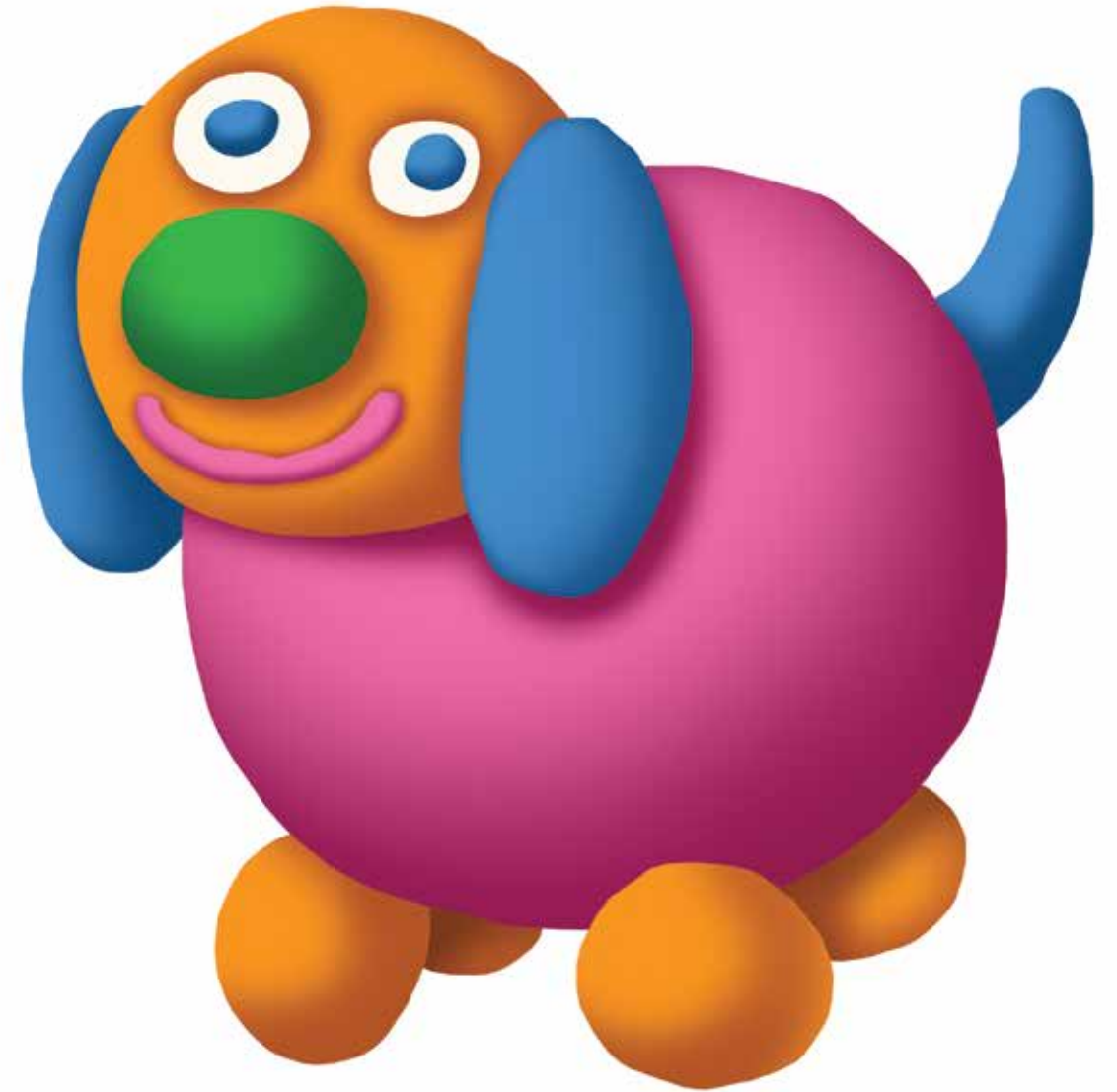


Ben makes a shape.

“I like that dog,” said Mom.



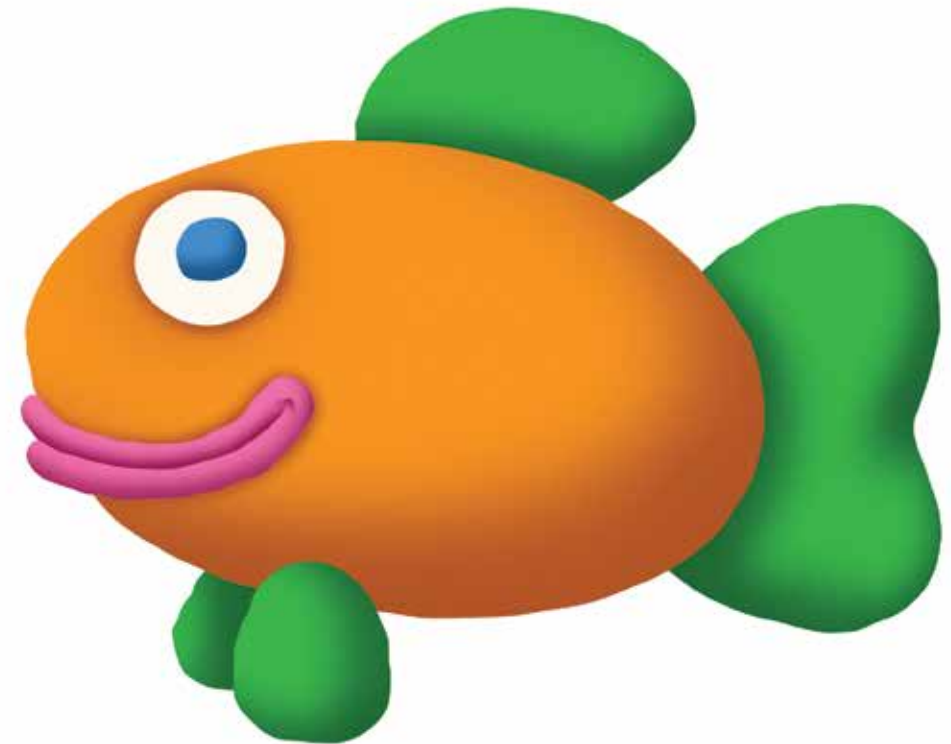
Ben makes a new shape.

“Is it a leaf?” said Mom.



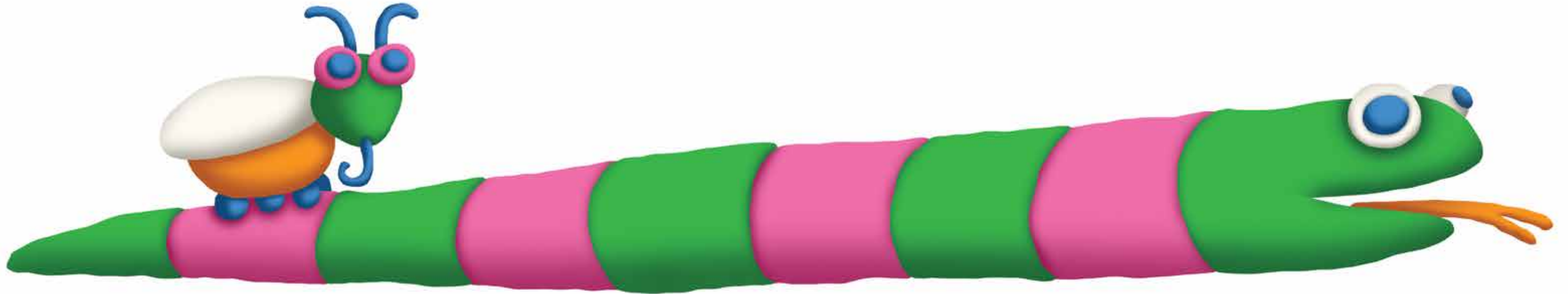
“No,” said Ben. He adds fins. “It is a fish.”
